

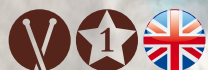

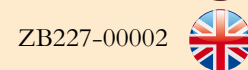

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## YARN

### Camello

- A Rich Red 004  
1 x 25gm
- B Stone 002  
2 x 25gm
- C Pavement 003  
1 x 25gm

## NEEDLES

- 1 pair 3¼mm (no 10) (US 3) needles
- 1 pair 4mm (no 8) (US 6) needles

## TENSION

27 sts and 41 rows to 10 cm measured over striped st st using 4mm (US 6) needles.

## HAT

Using 3¼mm (US 3) needles and yarn C cast on 156 sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** \*K3, P3, rep from \* to end.

**Row 2:** As row 1.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 29 rows, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

**Row 32 (WS):** Rib 15, work 2 tog, (rib 29, work 2 tog) 4 times, rib 15. 151 sts.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

Break off yarn C and join in yarn A.

Beg with a K row and joining in yarn B when required, now work in striped st st throughout as follows:

**Rows 1 to 6:** Using yarn A.

**Rows 7 to 12:** Using yarn B.

Last 12 rows form striped st st.

Keeping striped st st correct throughout, cont as follows:

Cont straight until hat meas 28 cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

## Shape crown

**Row 1 (RS):** (K13, K2tog) 10 times, K1. 141 sts.

Work 3 rows.

**Row 5:** (K12, K2tog) 10 times, K1. 131 sts.

Work 3 rows.

**Row 9:** (K11, K2tog) 10 times, K1. 121 sts.

Work 1 row.

**Row 11:** (K10, K2tog) 10 times, K1. 111 sts.

Work 1 row.

**Row 13:** (K9, K2tog) 10 times, K1. 101 sts.

Work 1 row.

**Row 15:** (K8, K2tog) 10 times, K1. 91 sts.

Work 1 row.

**Row 17:** (K7, K2tog) 10 times, K1. 81 sts.

**Row 18:** P1, (P2tog, P6) 10 times. 71 sts.

**Row 19:** (K5, K2tog) 10 times, K1. 61 sts.

**Row 20:** P1, (P2tog, P4) 10 times. 51 sts.

**Row 21:** (K3, K2tog) 10 times, K1. 41 sts.

**Row 22:** P1, (P2tog, P2) 10 times. 31 sts.

**Row 23:** (K1, K2tog) 10 times, K1. 21 sts.

**Row 24:** P1, (P2tog) 10 times.

Break yarn and thread through rem 11 sts. Pull up tight and fasten off securely.

## MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.

Join back seam using back stitch, or mattress stitch if preferred, reversing seam for section in yarn C (for turn-back). Fold 6 cm to RS around lower edge of hat (for turn-back). Make a 5 cm diameter pompon using yarn B and attach to top of hat.
