### What you will need:

**RED HEART® Super Saver®:** 1 skein each of 360 Café Latte **A**, 316 Soft White **B**, and 319 Cherry Red **C**. **Note:** Only a small amount of each yarn color is needed

**Susan Bates® Knitting**  
**Needles:** 3.75 mm [US 5].

Polyester fiberfill, 18" [45.5 cm] thin gold ribbon (for hanger), yarn needle.

**GAUGE:** 20 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 24 rows = 4" [10 cm] over Stockinette stitch (knit on right side, purl on wrong side). **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

### BUY YARN



**RED HEART® Super Saver®**, Art. E300 available in solid color 7 oz (198 g), 364 yds (333 m); stripes, prints, multis and heathers 5 oz (141 g), 236 yds (215 m); flecks 5 oz (141 g), 260 yds (238 m) skeins



## Cup of Cocoa Ornament

Knit a cup of cocoa for the tree and then make an actual cup to enjoy as you decorate your home. It's a heart-warming ornament to enjoy year after year.

**Ornament measures about 2¾" [12.5 cm] tall.**

### Notes

1. Cup of Coca is made from 5 pieces: Cocoa, Cup, Handle, and 2 Marshmallows.
2. All pieces are sewn together to complete the ornament.
3. Gauge is not critical for this project. Work tightly so stuffing will not show between stitches.
4. Use photograph as a guide for arrangement of pieces to be sewn together.

### Special Stitch

**kfb (Knit into front and back)** = Knit next stitch but do not remove from needle, knit into back loop of same stitch and remove from needle - 1 st increased.

### COCOA

With **A**, cast on 6 sts.

**Row 1 (right side):** Kfb in each st across—12 sts.

**Row 2:** Purl.

**Row 3:** [K1, kfb] 6 times—18 sts.

**Row 4:** Purl.

**Row 5:** [K2, kfb] 6 times—24 sts.

**Row 6:** Purl.

**Row 7:** [K3, kfb] 6 times—30 sts.

**Row 8:** Purl.

Bind off as if to knit. Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. With tail, sew side edges together to form a circle. Then thread tail through 6 cast-on sts and pull to close opening at center of circle. Weave in ends securely.

### CUP

Leaving a long beginning tail, with **B**, cast on 6 sts.

**Rows 1-5:** With **B**, work same as Rows 1-5 of Cocoa—24 sts.

**Row 6:** Knit.

Change to **C**.

**Row 7:** With **C**, [k3, kfb] 6 times—30 sts.

**Rows 8-10:** With **C**, work in Stockinette st (knit on right side, purl on wrong side) for 3 rows.

Change to **B**.

**Rows 11 and 12:** With **B**, knit.

Change to **C**.

**Rows 13-17:** With **C**, work in Stockinette stitch (knit on right side, purl on wrong side) for 5 rows.

**Rows 18-20:** With **C**, knit.

Bind off as if to knit. Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Thread beginning tail through 6 cast-on sts and pull to gather bottom of Cup. Continuing with beginning tail, sew side edges of Rows 1-6 together. With ending tail, sew remainder of side edges together. Weave in ends securely.

### HANDLE

With **C**, cast on 20 sts.

**Row 1:** Knit.

Bind off, leaving a long tail. Sew ends of Handle together to form a circle.

### MARSHMALLOW (make 2)

With **B**, cast on 4 sts.

**Row 1:** Kfb in each st across—8 sts.

**Rows 2 and 3:** Knit.

**Row 4:** Purl.

Bind off, leaving a long tail. With tail, sew top and side seams, do not sew bottom edge.

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### FINISHING

Stuff Cup with fiberfill. With **C**, sew edges of Cocoa inside Cup, 3 rows below top edge.

With **C**, sew Handle to one side of Cup.

With **B**, sew Marshmallows to Cocoa, overlapping one over the other.

Fold gold ribbon in half. Insert crochet hook around a few stitches at top of ornament, place ribbon fold on hook and draw through to form a loop. Thread ends of ribbon through loop and pull to tighten. Tie ends together with bow or overhand knot to form hanging loop.

Weave in any remaining ends.

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### ABBREVIATIONS

**A, B, and C** = Color A, Color B, and Color C; **k** = knit; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **[ ]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
