


Neckerchief Scarf

crocheted in Caron Cakes



MEASUREMENTS

Approx 60" [152.5 cm] long x 15" [38 cm] deep (at deepest point).

GAUGE

13 sc and 14 rows = 4" [10 cm].

Note that this pattern is written in US crochet terms!

MATERIALS

Caron® Cakes™ (7.1 oz/200 g; 350 m/383 yds)

Lemon Lime (17007) **1 ball**

Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

ABBREVIATIONS: www.yarnspirations.com/abbreviations

Approx = Approximate(ly)

Beg = Begin(ning)

Ch = Chain(s)

Dc = Double crochet

Dc2tog = (Yoh and draw up a loop in next stitch. Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook.

Dec = Decrease(ing)

Inc = Increase(ing)

Rem = Remain(ing)

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

St = Stitch(es)

Yoh = Yarn over hook

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Ch 3 at beg of row counts as dc.

Ch 4.

1st row: (RS). 1 dc in 4th ch from hook (counts as 2 dc). Turn.

2nd row: Ch 3. 2 dc in next dc. Turn. 3 dc.

3rd row: Ch 3. 1 dc in first dc. 1 dc in each dc to end of row. Turn. 4 dc.

4th row: Ch 3. 1 dc in each of next 2 dc. 2 dc in last dc. Turn. 5 dc.

5th row: Ch 3. 1 dc in first dc. 1 dc each dc to end of row. Turn. 6 dc.

6th row: Ch 3. 1 dc in each dc to last dc. 2 dc in last dc. Turn. 7 dc.

Rep last 2 rows, inc 1 dc every row at same edge until work measures approx 30" [76 cm] along straight side edge.

Beg dec: 1st row: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 1 dc in each dc to last 2 dc. Dc2tog. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 2. Yoh and draw up a loop in next st. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice – beg dc2tog made. 1 dc in each dc to end of row. Turn.

Rep last 2 rows, dec 1 st every row at same edge until there are 2 dc.

Next row: Beg dc2tog. Fasten off.

Tassels (make 2)

Cut a piece of cardboard 8" [20.5 cm] wide. Wind yarn around cardboard 30 times. Break yarn leaving a long end and thread end through needle. Slip needle through all loops and tie tightly. Remove cardboard and wind yarn tightly around loops $\frac{3}{4}$ " [2 cm] below fold. Fasten securely. Cut through rem loops and trim end evenly. Sew 1 Tassel to each point of Kerchief.
