Materials and Measurements

Approx width at widest point	51	cm
	20	ins
Approx height at widest point	41	cm
	16	ins
Robin Fleece 100g	4	balls
2- 6½mm (UK3 - US10½) knitting needles. Plus 1 spare 6½mm needle. Stuffing.		
Photographed in shades:- 4222 Coral.		

IMPORTANT

Use only the Wendy yarn specified. We cannot accept responsibility for an imperfect project if any other brand is used. It is essential to work to the tension stated. The quantities of yarn stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

ABBREVIATIONS

K - knit; **st(s)** - stitch(es); **tog** - together; **rept** - repeat; **cm** - centimetres; **ins** - inches; **g st** - garter stitch (every row knit); **Kfb** - knit front and back (1 st increase).

TENSION

It is important to check your tension before commencing the project. 14 sts and 14 rows to 10cm, 4ins over g st on 6½mm needles. If there are too many stitches to 10cm, then your tension is tight and you will need to change your needle to a larger size. If there are too few stitches to 10cm, then your tension is loose and you will need to change your needle to a smaller size.

HEART CUSHION

FRONT AND BACK (both alike)

Using 6½mm needles, cast on 2 sts.

1st row - K2.

2nd row - Kfb, Kfb. 4 sts.

3rd row - Kfb, K to last st, Kfb. 6 sts.

Rept the last row until there are 54 sts.

Next row - Knit.

Next row - Kfb, K to last st, Kfb. 56 sts.

Rept last 2 rows until there are 64 sts.

Knit 4 rows.

Next row - Kfb, K to last st, Kfb. Rept last 5 rows until there are 72 sts.

Knit 4 rows.

Next row - K2tog, K to last st, K2tog.

Knit 1 row.

Rept last 2 rows till 64 sts.

Shape Top

1st row - K32, turn and work on this set of sts using the spare needle, leaving remaining st on their needle.

2nd row - K2tog, K to last 2 sts, K2tog. 30 sts.

3rd row - K to last 2 sts, K2tog. 29 sts.

4th row - K2tog, K to end. 28 sts.

5th row - K2tog, K to last 2 sts, K2tog. 26 sts.

6th row - K2tog, K to end. 25 sts.

7th row - K2tog, K to last 2 sts, K2tog. 23 sts.

8th row - As 7th row. 21 sts.

9th row - Knit.

10th row - As 7th row. 19 sts.

11th row - Knit.

12th row - K2tog, K2tog, K to last 4 sts, K2tog, K2tog. 15 sts.

13th row - As 12th row. 11 sts.

14th row - K2tog, K2tog, K to end. 9 sts.

15th row - K to last 4 sts, K2tog, K2tog. 7 sts.

16th row - K2tog, K to last 2 sts, K2tog. 5 sts.

Cast off.

With right side facing rejoin yarn to centre of Heart and work 2nd to 16th rows.

MAKING UP

Place right sides of cushion together and sew round the edge of the cushion using back stitch. Leave a small opening long one side. turn the cushion right way out and stuff. Sew up the opening using top sewing.
