

Christmas Pom Pom Wreath

made using DROPS Nepal & DROPS Glitter



MATERIALS:

DROPS Nepal:

(Aran weight 65% Wool, 35% Alpaca yarn, available in 50g balls.)

We used the following shades:

- 3608 (Deep Red)
- 1477 (Pistachio)
- 3620 (Red)
- 7238 (Olive Mix)
- 0100 (OffWhite)



DROPS Glitter:

in shade 01 (Gold)

(Available in 10g balls - 700 metre length.)



A 25cm Rico Polystyrol Wreath Ring

(Also available in 12cm, 15cm, 20cm and 30cm diametres.)



A Clover Pom Pom Maker



Some Long Pins

INSTRUCTIONS:

Making a pom pom wreath is so simple, and there's so much scope for creativity!

MAKING YOUR POM POMS:

We used a Clover Pom Pom Maker to make our pom poms. We used one strand of DROPS Nepal with one strand of DROPS Glitter, for an extra bit of sparkle.

ATTACHING YOUR POM POMS:

We pinned our pom poms onto the wreath using long pins, but tying your pom poms on or using a glue gun also works really well.

FINISHING TOUCHES:

When you're happy with your wreath, simply attach a loop of ribbon or yarn to the back, and it's ready to hang!

Rather than making enough pom poms to cover your whole wreath, you could also try wrapping yarn around it for a different look!
